Dorothy A. Bohaty, 87, of David City died Wednesday August 1, 2012 at the Butler County Health Care Center.

Mass of Christian Burial will be Monday August 6, 2012 at 10 AM at St. Mary's Catholic Church in David City with Fr. Bernard Kimminau as celebrant. Interment will follow at St. Mary's Cemetery.
