Richard S. Longenecker, 82, of David City, died Thursday, December 6, 2007 at Butler County Health Care Center in David City. Services will be held at 10:00am Monday, December 10, 2007 at St. Mary's Catholic Church, David City. Burial will be in the Mt. Olivet Cemetery, Manilla, Iowa, on Monday, December 10, 2007 at 3:30pm.
